- Golf shoes must be worn at all times on the course.
- The following items are not permitted under any circumstances on the golf course, Tracksuits, Sweatpants or any Blue Denim clothing, Trainers, Cut-down or frayed shorts, cargo / combat / beach / board shorts or trousers, collarless shirts, Rugby and Football shirts or T- shirts.
- 5. Gents' Shirts should be tucked into trousers and shorts at all times.
- 6. Baseball and golf caps if worn must be worn with the peak to the front.
- 7. Some Ladies' golf clothing such as golf dresses, Capris, shorts and skorts are designed to be golfing attire along with tops which are worn over shorts, skirts or trousers and these are permitted.
- 8. Directors of The Club, the Professional and other Authorised staff may approach those not adhering to the Club's Course Dress Code and advise players accordingly; if a player refuses to comply with such a request they may be warned or refused access to, or invited to leave, the course.
- 9. The acceptance of a tee time by any member, society or individual green fee payer will be deemed as acceptance of the Club's Terms and Conditions in their entirety which are available to view on the Club's website and Club V1 app.
- 10. In order to encourage participation in our sport the Club reserves the right to amend or change the course dress code at its discretion.
