## **Bingley St. Ives Golf Club Ltd**

## Open Days - Terms and Conditions of Entry

- 1. All entrants for Open Days must conform to the definition of Amateur status as defined by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews.
- 2. All entries must be accompanied by the correct administrative information, i.e. the players' correct names, CDH numbers and World Handicap System (WHS) Handicap Indexes and the entry fee; if not a tee time will not be reserved.
- 3. All players must be current members of a Golf Club affiliated to England Golf and have a current WHS Handicap Index.
- 4. A change of player is allowed but the Professional must be advised immediately and supplied with the players details as above
- 5. The Women's Handicap Index limit is 30.3 and the Men's Handicap Index limit is 25.5
- 6. Competitors will play off the tees specified for each competition and use those stroke indexes.
- 7. Juniors are welcome to enter; however, an adult must be present in any group with a playing junior.
- 8. The closing date is the date shown on the club website and / or Club V1 app / How Did I Do / Golf Empire; no refunds will be made after this date unless the course is deemed unplayable.
- 9. All competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and to the local rules pertaining to the course at the time of play.
- 10. Ties will be decided by reference to the club's competition policy, i.e. back 9, back 6, back 3 and the last hole. Disputes will be referred to the Competition Committee whose decision shall be final.
- 11. Prize winners will be announced within 48 hours of the close of play (unless a dispute has yet to be resolved) and results published on the club website and / or How Did I Do / Golf Empire.
- 12. On entry, all competitors agree to abide by the club's code of conduct, and course and clubhouse dress codes at all times. These are published on the club's website and Club V1 app
- 13. On entry, all competitors agree to obey any instructions given by a Director of the Club, The Professional or other Authorised Officer.
- 14. The Bingley St Ives Golf Club Ltd reserves the right to refuse any player's application for entry for whatever reasons it deems fit and shall not be required to disclose such reasons.
- 15. Green keepers have priority on the course at all times
- 16. The acceptance of a tee time will be deemed as acceptance of the Club's Terms and Conditions and Dress Code in their entirety.
- 17. Players must have adequate Golf related insurance cover and indemnify BSIGC Ltd from any responsibility or consequences from their actions.
